Oh, how I love them so.

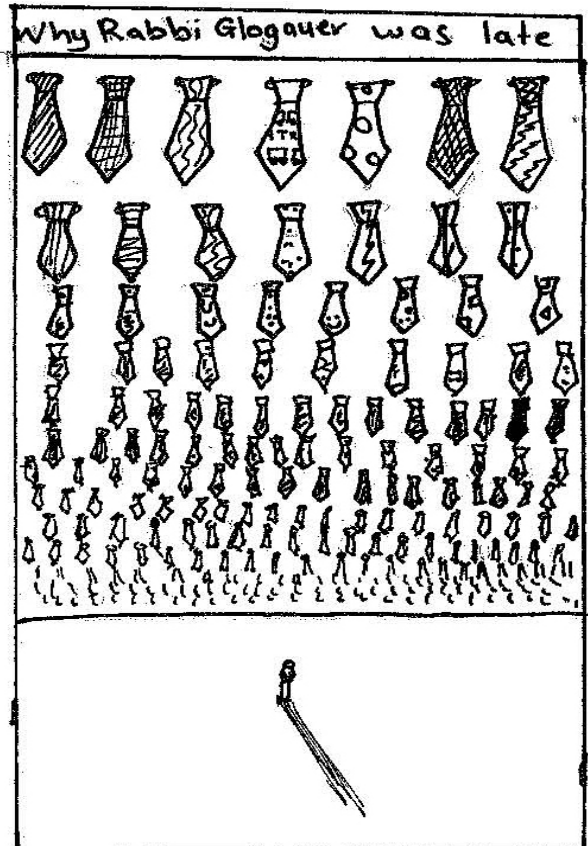

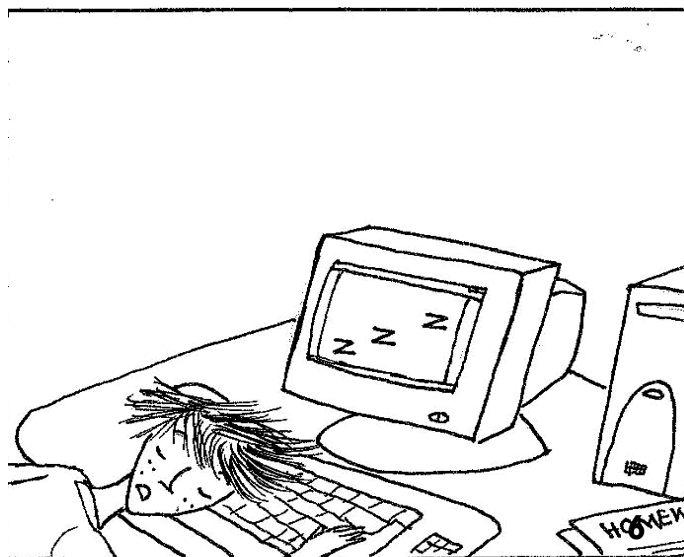
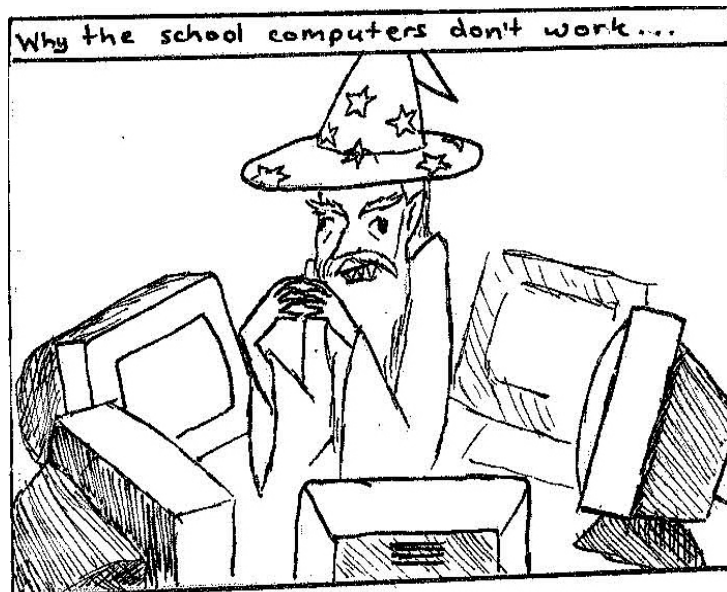

And now; chips of wood on the floor, glue on everything, needles broken, fluff everywhere, projects left out, a table devoted to rats? Who can blame him?

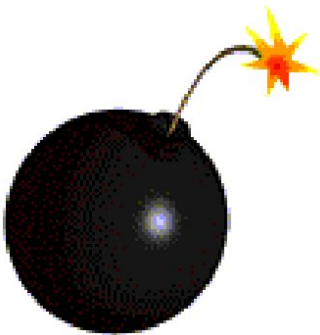
Will this ever cease?
